

**HELMET FIT:** A correctly fitted helmet should feel like an even amount of pressure is being exerted around your head and cheeks. But, helmet's break in, so it should fit as tight as you can comfortably wear it. Once fastened, you should **NOT** be able to pull it off your head in any direction. Attention first-time helmet buyers: If your helmet is loose at all, and doesn't fit well, it **CANNOT** deliver the best protection. A helmet's strict safety standards can be compromised after only one impact collision. If the integrity is in question, send it back to us for proper inspection.
